Single Engine, Fixed Gear Cessna 182

Any club member of active status holding a currently effective FAA Private, Commercial, or Air Transport Pilot certificate with single engine land rating may operate the club's single engine, fixed gear Cessna 182 aircraft provided they:

Have logged 100 hours PIC time and provided they have completed the club's C182 training and checkout procedure process.
